Most recently, she was a senior specialist in DTE Energy's Media Relations Department.

Donerson holds a Master's in Public Relations from Michigan State University and a Bachelor of Science in Journalism, with a minor in political science, from Northwestern University's Medill School of Journalism. She is a member of the national executive Board of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., the Public Relations Society of America, the National Association of Black Journalists and The Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi.
